

## **Corrections Lexipol Grant**

## Fiscal Year 2014-2015

QUALIFYING CIS MEMBERS CAN APPLY!

Members with CIS Liability coverage are eligible to submit for reimbursement of up to 50% off the first year's fees to implement the Lexipol Corrections Policy Development program. Budgeted funds for the 50% reimbursable grant are awarded on a first-applied, first-granted basis.

After your grant approval and purchase of your Lexipol Corrections policy program you will need to submit the following for your reimbursement

- 1. A copy of your contract with Lexipol
- 2. A copy of your paid invoice
- 3. A copy of the signed check. (If you pay for your Lexipol policy program with a credit or debit card, we will need a copy of the receipt or statement showing the program purchased.)

## **Lexipol Corrections Grant Program:**

Lexipol is a risk management company that provides the framework and recommendations for law enforcement agencies to develop public safety policy manuals online, and then provides training on the policy for officers. - Training

- Supervision
- Discipline

These five areas require ongoing review of best practices and recent case decisions to help manage corrections employees and departments. Being able to monitor these changes, interpret and translate the changes and demonstrate how they affect corrections on a state and national level is a key benefit of becoming a Lexipol member.

In addition, the policy manual content developed by Lexipol is compatible with any accreditation standards. Lexipol automatically cross-reference's applicable policy with accreditation standards.
