How CIS IS Different from an Insurance Company

- Market is limited by the CIS Bylaws
 - Serves specific public customers
 - Only serves a certain group of public agencies:
 - Oregon cities, Oregon counties and public bodies created by those cities or counties that
 - Provide service that a city or county would otherwise provide, and
 - Are subject to the Oregon Tort Claims Act.



Criteria for Joining CIS

- Membership in either the LOC or AOC
- Not a city or county?
 - Can obtain an associate membership with one of CIS' "parents"
 - To retain coverage, must continue with AOC or LOC membership
